There is an excellent example featuring WuggestionPopup in wt-4.8.0/examples/feature/suggestionpopup/ It is possible to choose a suggestion using the keys: up, down and enter. However, if I replace this line: <pre>setCssTheme ("polished");</pre> by these, <pre>auto bootstrapTheme = std::make_shared&lt;Wt::WBootstrap5Theme&gt; (); setTheme (bootstrapTheme);</pre> The focus on the suggested items does not change as I press up and down. However, the WuggestionPopup keeps track of the keys up and down because once I press enter, the selected item is correct. To use WBootstrap5Theme I added the line

I tested with Bootstrap 3 Theme replacing previous lines with,

```
auto bootstrapTheme = std::make_shared<Wt::WBootstrapTheme> ();  
bootstrapTheme->setVersion (Wt::BootstrapVersion::v3);  
bootstrapTheme->setResponsive (true);  
setTheme (bootstrapTheme);  
useStyleSheet ("resources/themes/bootstrap/3/bootstrap-theme.min.css");
```

Adding this line,

```
#include
```

The focus on the suggestions change with the keys up and down, exactly as with Polished theme.

The focus does not change with Bootstrap 5.
