Conceptually, Wt implements a single-page application, and it is thus straight forward to have a consistent look and feel throughout. You can use a HTML/CSS-based template (straight forward using WTemplate), for example.

Even for widgets that are styled by Wt (such as table views, tab widgets, ...), using a CSS theme, the style can be entirely customized and tailored to your demands.
