Description often it makes sense to put in the place of the title of a WPanel an anchor, line edit, etc., or combination of controls. At the moment WPanel is limited to setText (with WText). The titleBarWidget is private, thus cannot touch it. Simple use cases: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• you want to put a link (WAnchor) in a WPanel's titleBarWidget, but initially hide the description of a link.• you want to define an input control. In this input control you can either input the "simple way" and then you would put a text input widget in place of the title. If the "simple way" is not possible you open the panel and use the unhidden controls.
