when I use a WinPlaceEdit widget and disable the Cancel and Save Buttons using <code>setButtonsEnabled(false)</code> and clicking on the inplace edit only each second click has an active focus of the WLineEdit widget. With buttons enabled the focus is always set correctly. This bug is annoying since you need to click twice to be able to enter some text...			
Also it would be nice to have an constructor which can disable the buttons on construction!
