<p>Hey,</p> <p>after wt-3.3.1 (tested for 3.3.3 and 3.3.4-rc1) I cannot click on a button in a modal WDialog when JavaScript is disabled in Firefox. Moreover the WDialog is not rendered in the middle of the browser window as in 3.3.1.</p> <p>Perhaps, the problem is in the button wrap.</p> <p>In IE11 and Chrome it works with the button wrapper, but the dialogue is still not centered.</p> <p>I built wt with minGW for reference, but I couldn't reproduce it. Neither the positioning nor the buttons accessibility.</p> <p>I'll appreciate a fix for 3.3.4 release</p> <p>Best regards,</p> <p>Stoycho</p>
