<p>CSS Flexbox allows to do many of the things directly in CSS, which layout managers now do using JavaScript. From a first reading, it seems that flexbox is a superset of layout manager capabilities, perhaps with some exceptions (such as resize handles).</p> <p>The current JavaScript could be retained (and expanded) for older browsers.</p> <p>This could bring with it some behavioural changes to layout managers (if rendered with flexbox).</p>
