Description			
<p>I have an embedded device running WT, using WT's built in web server.</p> <p>On the web page I have a small window with google maps (among other things).</p> <p>When the PC/browser accessing the device does not have an Internet connection, the entire web interface is blocked/unusable/stalls.</p> <p>I would expect the window with google maps to be unusable, but it seems to block the entire web interface.</p> <p>Is there a way around this, so the remaining parts of the web interface is usable?.</p> <p>I have a small example program, it shows white screen/nothing loaded, if PC/browser does not have Internet connection:</p> <pre>WApplication *createApplication(const WEnvironment& env) { Wt::WApplication *app = new Wt::WApplication(env); app->setTheme(new Wt::WBootstrapTheme(app)); app~root()>addWidget(new Wt::WText("MAP")); Wt::WGoogleMap *map_ = new Wt::WGoogleMap(); approot()~>addWidget(map_); app->triggerUpdate(); return app; }</pre>
